- The Singita Community Culinary School is a community partnership programme that produces 6-10 internationally qualified commis chefs every year.
- The school has a state-of-the-art demonstration studio at Singita Lebombo Lodge, where guests can take part in pre-arranged cooking classes.
- Classes should be booked at least 24 hours in advance to allow the chefs enough time to prepare.
- The classes can be scheduled any day of the week, subject to availability.
- A professional, qualified chef leads the classes.
- Guests can either cook a traditional South African dish, or one of the trademark dishes from the lodge's menu.
