Daily game drives

Set off each morning and evening on drives across the concession to observe wildlife up close, learn about the region's natural and cultural heritage from our insightful guides, and explore what each day in nature reveals. Vehicles accommodate a maximum of eight people.

Guided bush walks

Exploring the landscape on foot, led by a guide, offers a more intimate perspective and a deeper understanding of the ecosystem. We recommend a minimum age of 16 years for this experience, though participation is at the discretion of a guide.

Birdwatching

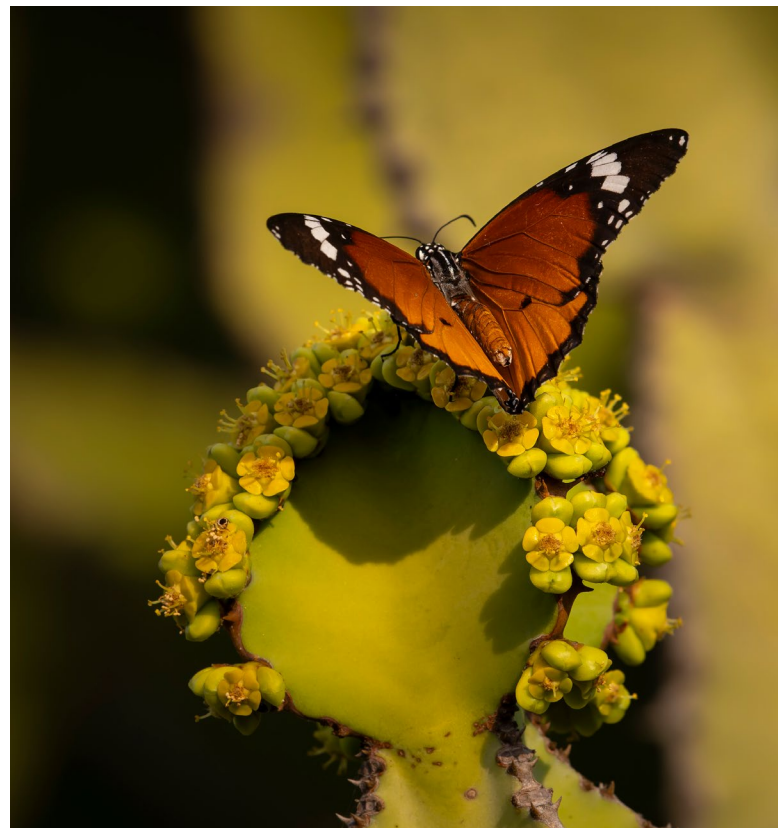

Fitness space

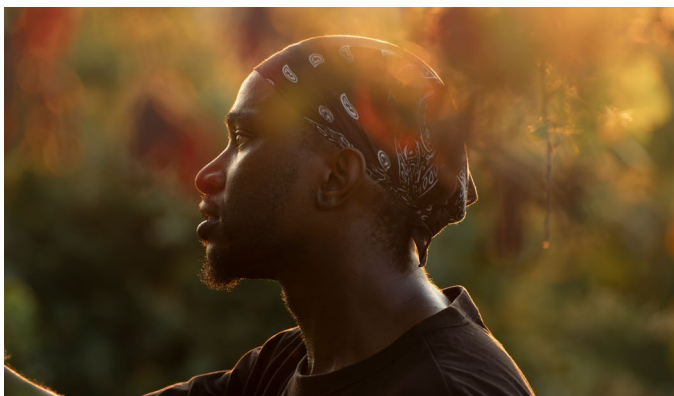
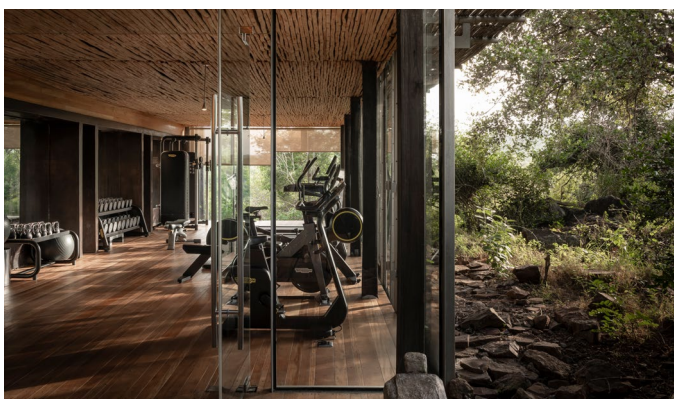
