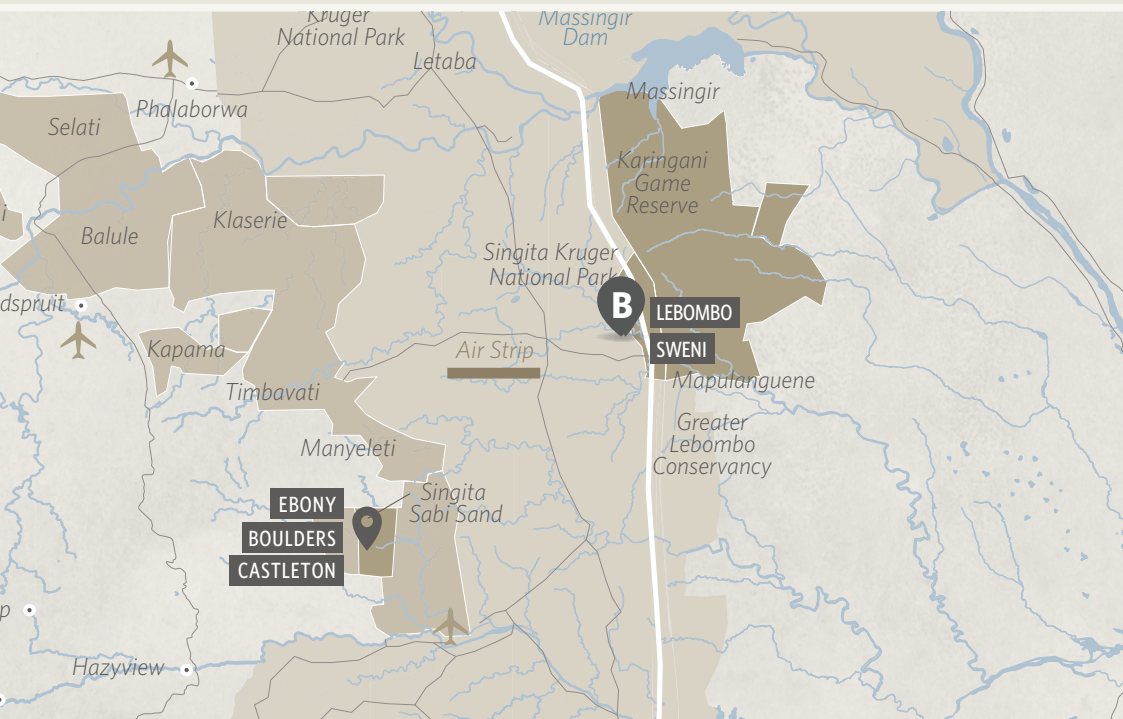
Our location
