Seasons

WINTER

April to October

- Great wildlife viewing.
- Shorter grass and less water forces animals to concentrate around water sources

SUMMER

November to March

- Short afternoon thunderstorms and lush landscapes.
- Many species give birth at the start of the rains.



Health requirements

MALARIA

- Singita's properties in South Africa are situated in malaria-risk areas. It is therefore essential that guests consult their doctor or a travel clinic regarding anti-malaria requirements prior to their journey.

YELLOW FEVER

- South Africa requires all travellers journeying from or transiting through yellow fever-risk countries to show proof of a vaccination in the form of a valid yellow fever certificate.

Lebombo	<p>A rugged mosaic of wilderness stretches to every horizon from the ridge where Lebombo sits. Expansive windows open to an endless sky, framing sweeping views of valley and river below. Spaces merge, each drawing the outside in, along with sounds and elements that soothe you. Warm, earthy tones soften the senses, while rustling canopies and grazing antelope pass along walkways — reminders that the wild is never far. In its elevation, a quiet stillness settles. Dappled light paints shifting patterns across every surface, and a vivid, playful palette draws your eye to small wonders — the flicker of a bird in flight, the curve of a branch, the shimmer of the river. Here, you are gently caressed by colour, chosen intuitively and inspired by jewel tones hidden in the trees, subtly shaping how you feel without needing to understand why.
