All You Need to Know about Elela

Elela means 'to flow' in Setswana, a concept captured in more than its name.

Here, the Delta is more than a setting — it's the experience itself. Mesh walls usher the breeze, floods pass beneath walkways, and circular camps open to the landscape on all sides. Winds change, waters swell and recede, and the sun shifts constantly, revealing a different experience in every moment.

Both in the privacy of your camp and the hub at the heart of the property, there's no separation between inside and out, guest and guide, you and the wild. Here, you learn to see all that you didn't know to look for, and days take their shape from instinct.

DETAILS

- Eight private camps: five one-bedroom, two two-bedroom, and one four-bedroom.
- Each camp includes a private vehicle, guide, tracker, arrival point, and Camp Manager; and indoor and outdoor living spaces, a fireplace and firepit, a kitchen, a pool (heated in winter), and a lounge where wellness rituals take place on request.
- The four-bedroom camp includes two private vehicles, a wine cellar, a fitness space, and a personal chef.
- The rooms in every camp are the same size, but the two and four-bedroom camps feature a closable screen for added privacy and shelter.
- Camps are circular, raised on stilts, and open on all sides, offering 360° views of the landscape.

CONCESSION & SETTING

Located in NG26 — 420,000 acres of private wilderness in the Delta's central western region.

A true reflection of the Delta ecosystem, the concession is made up of waterways, islands, lagoons, grasslands, and swamps that shift with the seasons.

Abundant resident and migratory wildlife.



GUEST EXPERIENCE

- Days are guided by intuition — guests set their own pace and choose what they want to do. Their Camp Manager is always available to arrange anything.
- Daily drives, guided walks, boat trips, mokoro (traditional dugout canoe) excursions, helicopter flights, fishing, birdwatching, stargazing, wellness rituals, swimming, fitness spaces, wine tastings and pairings, Conservation Lounge, Boutique & Gallery, and yoga.
- Children of all ages are welcome.
- A minimum age requirement applies to certain experiences.

THE HUB

- A shared space at the centre of the property, accessible by walkway or a short drive.
- Includes shared dining spaces (indoor/outdoor), a communal fitness space, a Conservation Lounge, and the regional Singita Community Culinary School.
- Transparent by design — kitchens, offices, and staff areas are open to guests, encouraging deep, genuine connection.
- Open year-round (refer to our Botswana Destination Guide for seasonal highlights).

TRAVELLING TO ELELA

Daily scheduled flights via Mack Air from Maun and Kasane to the Singita Airstrip — 15 minutes from Elela.
